Dear Mr. Tunstall:

On December 30, 1987, we met to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The issue in this grievance is whether the Bulk Mail Clerk position was properly awarded.

During our discussion, we agreed to the following:

1. In filling the position in question, the provisions of Articles 37.3.A(1), 37.3.F(5) and 37.3.F(7) (1984 National Agreement) are to be followed.

Accordingly, we agreed to remand this case to the parties at Step 3 for application of the above language and further processing.
