Dear Mr. Baldwin:

On July 5, 1983, we met with you to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The matters presented by you as well as the applicable contractual provisions have been reviewed and given careful consideration.

In full settlement of the subject grievance, it is agreed:

1. An Employer who previously failed the Window Service Training Program will be entitled to bid on a duty assignment with window service duties no sooner than 180 calendar days following the unsuccessful completion of the Window Service Training Program..
2. Effective immediately Clerk Morgan shall be eligible to bid on Distribution Window and Mark-Up Clerk or other window positions.
