
Recently you met with Frank Dyer in pre-arbitration discussion of H8C-2B-C 10868, Camden, New Jersey. The issue in this case is whether management violated Article 37 by administering a Window Clerk examination 49 days after the grievant had completed training. It was mutually agreed to full settlement of this case as follows:

1. The Window Clerk examination is to be conducted on the last day of training. In the instant case, this did not happen.
2. If the grievant so desires, he will be allowed to retrain and take a timely examination. If he passes the examination, he will be placed in the next window clerk vacancy.
3. The grievant will have 30 days from the date of this settlement to advise the Postmaster, in writing, if he so desires to be trained as a window clerk.

Please sign the enclosed copy of this letter acknowledging your agreement with this settlement, withdrawing H8C-2B-C 10868 from the pending national arbitration listing.
