

Dear Mr. Wilson:

On January 13, 1984, we met to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The grievance concerns whether local management in this case can deny the senior bidder an opportunity to enter the window services training program beyond the 180 days set in a national prearbitration settlement.

We mutually agreed that the intent of the settlement agreement was that an employee who previously failed the Window Service Training Program will be entitled to bid on an assignment with window service duties no sooner than 180 calendar days after failing and to reenter the necessary training as required, if the employee is the senior bidder.

Please sign and return the enclosed copy of this decision as acknowledgment of agreement to resolve this case.
