

Dear Mr. Wilson:

On May 31, 1984, we met to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The grievance involves a local policy published on July 27, 1983, which provided that an employee will only be able to be gualifying for one bid at a time.

During our discussion, we agreed to settle the case based on our understanding that a successful bidder may, under the provisions of Article 37.3.F.8, remain live bidder on other bids so long as the requirement specified are met.

Accordingly, as agreed, the case is remanded to Step 3 for application of the above settlement and appropriate resolution.

Please sign and return the enclosed copy of this decision as your acknowledgment of agreement to settle and remand this case.
