Dear Mr. Wilson:

On March 19, 1983, we met to discuss the above-captioned case at the fourth step of the contractual grievance procedure set forth in the 1981 National Agreement.

The question raised in this grievance involved out-of-schedule overtime pay for time that the grievant spent in a Window Services Technician position as a result of an erroneous selection.

After further review of this matter, we mutually agreed that no national interpretive issue is fairly presented in the particulars evidenced in this case. There is no dispute between the parties relative to the one year of experience as a Window Clerk that is required in order to qualify for the Window Services Technician position.

Accordingly, as we further agreed, this case is hereby remanded to the parties at Step 3 for further processing if necessary.
