Dear Mr. Wevodau:

On June 9, 1987, we met to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The issue in this grievance is whether managment violated the National Agreement by contracting out custodial work.

After reviewing this matter, we mutually agreed that no national interpretive issue is fairly presented in this case. We agreed the matter is suitable for regional determination by application of the Collins Award in case number H4T-3W-C 9682 to the facts involved.

Accordingly, we agreed to remand this case to the parties at Step 3 for further processing, including arbitration if necessary.

Please sign and return the enclosed copy of this letter as your acknowledgment of agreement to remand this case.

Time limits were extended by mutual consent.
