Dear Mr. Baldwin:

On November 30, 1981, we met with you to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The matters presented by you as well as the applicable contractual provisions have been reviewed and given careful consideration.

We mutually agreed that if both full-time and part-time flexible employees are part of a rotating LSM crew and during the sweep cycle, it is necessary to reduce the number of employees participating in the sweeping, normally, a successful bidder shall work his/her duty assignment in accordance with Article XXXVII, Section 3.F.ll., of the National Agreement. For example, if during the sweep cycle only 3 of 4 employees are needed, normally, any PTF who is participating in the sweeping should be reassigned before a successful bidder, unless the PTF is being trained.

Please sign the attached copy of this decision as your acknowledgment of agreement to resolve this case.
