Dear Mr. Tunstall:

On June 27, 1985, we met to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The issue in this grievance is whether an unassigned regular's duty assignment must be posted when the employee receives a regular position.

It is the position of the postal service that there is no requirement to post the duty assignment that is vacated by an unassigned regular. These duty assignments are not vacancies and are not subject to any of the posting provisions.

In this grievance, local management's decision not to post a vacated unassigned regular's duty assignment was proper. Accordingly, the grievance is denied.
