On April 1, 1985, we met to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The issue in this grievance is whether management properly reverted a T-6 Window Clerk position at the West Hollywood Branch.

After further review of this matter, we mutually agreed that no national interpretive issue is fairly presented in this case. Whether management properly reverted the subject position is an issue suitable for regional determination based upon the specific fact circumstances.

Accordingly, we agreed to remand this case to Step 3 for further consideration by the parties.
