Dear Mr. Guffy:

On May 28, 1987, we met to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The issue in this grievance is whether casuals were scheduled to the detriment of part-time flexible clerks.

After reviewing this matter, we mutually agreed that no national interpretive issue is fairly presented in this case. Therefore, we further agreed to remand this case for application of the attached memo dated June 22, 1976, subject "Utilization of Casual Employees" to the particular fact circumstances involved.

Accordingly, we agreed to remand this case to the parties at Step 3 for further processing, including arbitration if necessary.

Please sign and return the enclosed copy of this letter as your acknowledgment of agreement to remand this case.
