On June 13, 1991, we met to discuss the above-captioned case at the fourth step of our contractual procedure.

The issue in this grievance is whether management violated the National Agreement by designating The Mail Handler Craft as the primary craft for sweeping and other allied duties on the Small Parcel and Bundle Sorter (SPBS).


During our discussion, we identified this case as being similar to case M7C-NA-C 69 which is currently pending arbitration at the national level.
