Dear Mr. Wilson:

On February 10, 1982, we met to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure as set forth in Article 15, Section 2 of the National Agreement.

The matters presented by you as well as the applicable contractual provisions have been reviewed and given careful consideration relevant to the employees' improper compensation for out-of-schedule overtime.

It is our position that the employees in question were properly scheduled for the two (2) hours of out-of-schedule overtime, worked the overtime and should therefore be compensated for the time worked out-of-schedule. Disallowed time should have been deducted from the regular tour of duty at the straight time rate.

Corrections will be made for the effected employees commensurate with this decision.
