On December 14, 1982, we met with you to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The matters presented by you as well as the applicable contractual provisions have been reviewed and given careful consideration.


The question raised in this grievance is whether the grievant was properly compensated for night differential for the period of time she received window training after being permanently assigned to the schedule of her bid Distribution/Window clerk position.

A thorough review of available information revealed no evidence that a contractual violation occurred in the circumstances present in this case. Management correctly applied the provisions of Management Instruction EL-730-90-11, Section II. C.3., and ELM 434.222 to the fact circumstances in this case.

Accordingly, as we find no violation of the 1981 National Agreement, this grievance is denied.

The time limits were extended by mutual agreement.
