On November 6, 1974, we met with you to discuss the abovecaptioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The requirement that employees complete a Form 3971 when they are unable to remain on duty in an overtime status is not a violation of the National Agreement. Management may use the means necessary to efficiently conduct its operations. Therefore, the grievance is denied.
