Dear Mr. Johnson:

This letter supersedes our decision dated december 15, 1982.

The question raised in this grievance involves whether local management violated the terms of the 1981 National Agreement by not specifically providing for additional wash-up time when carriers use a self-service gas pump.


It was mutually agreed that the following would represent a full settlement of this case:


On days that carriers use self-service gas pumps to fuel their assigned vehicles, they will be allowed to wash their hands. However, no additional time allowances will be credited for such wash-up.

Please sign and return the enclosed copy of this decision as your acknowledgment of agreement to resolve this case.

Time limits were extended by mutual consent.
