In July 22, 1986, we met to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The issue in this grievance is whether the grievant was entitled to return to his former craft assignment after being a supervisor.

During our discussion, we mutually agreed that the following constitutes full and final settlement of this grievance:

- The grievant has no right to return to his former preferred duty assignment.
- The grievant began a new period of seniority in accordance with Article 12, Section 2B(2) of the National Agreement.
