Dear Mr. Overby:

On November 24, 1982, you met with Frank Dyer in pre-arbitration discussion of H8N-4J-C 33933, Milwaukee, Wisconsin. The issue in this case is whether management violated the National Agreement by reassigning the employee to another craft due to his inability to work safely.

It was mutually agreed to full settlement of this case as follows:

- The Postal Service may discuss with an employee his/her safety record.
- 2. An employee may volunteer for reassignment to another craft. However, the Postal Service may not unilaterally make such a reassignment.

Please sign the enclosed copy of this letter acknowledging your agreement with this settlement, withdrawing H8N-4J-C 33933 from the pending national arbitration listing.
