Dear Mr. Guffey:

On October 26, 1987, we met to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The issue in this grievance is whether management violated Article 14 of the National Agreement by utilizing "Scent Go Mighty Mite Wick Deordorant" at the Omaha Facility.

After reviewing this matter, we mutually agreed that no national interpretive issue is fairly presented in this case.

Whether management violated Article 14 of the National Agreement by utilizing "Scent Go Mighty Mite Wick Deordorant" can only be determined by evaluation of the fact circumstances locally.

Accordingly, we agreed to remand this case to the parties at Step 3 for further processing, including arbitration if necessary.
