On October 28, 1976, we met with you to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The matters presented by you as well as the applicable contractual provisions have been reviewed and given careful consideration.

The safety officer inspected the A frames and did not find them to be a safety hazard. The removal of the upper shelfs of the A frame is not within the purview of local management. Such a request would be discussed at the National level jointly by management's safety committee. No violation of the National Agreement existed, therefore, this grievance is denied.
