Recently, you met with Frank Dyer in pre-arbitration discussion of H8C-4H-C 16085 and H8C-5K-C 13970. The question in these grievances involves the alleged unsafe practice of clearing dropper jams on MPLSM's.

It was mutually agreed to full settlement of these cases as follows:

The Postal Service is currently placing into effect a modification of the dropper jams. This modification will satisfy the dispute of these grievances.
