

On Movember 28 you met with Frank Dyer in prearbitration discussion of H1C-4B-C 1716, Flint, Michigan. The question in this grievance is whether management violated the National Agreement by permitting a supervisor to be an observer at a -rievance discussion between a local steward and an acting pervisor (204-B).

Either party may have an observer at a grievance discussion. Normally, it is expected that the parties will advise each other in advance of any intent to have an observer.
