On January 7, 1987, we met to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The issue in this grievance is whether management violated the National Agreement by denying the grievant information.

During our discussion, we mutually agreed that under Article 31, Section 2, of the National Agreement, Request for information pertaining to purely local matters should be submitted by local union representative to the installation head. If relevancy can be established pursuant to the provisions of Article 31, then management will provide such information to the union.
