Under the Privacy Act, the grievant may review and have copies of any information pertaining to himself that is contained in a record filed or cross-indexed under his name or other identifier except those specific records exempted by Part 353.325 of the Administrative Support Manual or any applicable law determined to apply in this case.

Any Postal Inspection Service records subject to disclosure under the above provision must still be disclosed only on the authority of the Chief Postal Inspector (353.325).
