

Dear Mr. Wilson:

On June 20, 1983, we met to discuss the above-captioned case at the fourth step of the contractual grievance procedure set forth in the 1981 National Agreement.

The question raised in this grievance involved the denial of a request by the grievant to review her OWCP file.

Whether the information requested should be released is a question suitable for determination at the regional level. Further guidance to resolve this dispute is contained in 353.324 and 353.326 of the Administrative Support Manual.

Accordingly, as we further agreed, this case is hereby remanded to the parties at Step 3 for further processing, if necessary.

Please sign and return the enclosed copy of this letter as your acknowledgment of agreement to remand this case.

Time limits were extended by mutual consent.
