

On May 20, 1982, we met to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure set forth in the 1981 National Agreement.

The question raised in this grievance involved whether anagement officials violated Article 17 by being present the Union addressed new employees during orientation.
