On April 13, 1982, we met to discuss the above-captioned prievance at the fourth step of the contractual grievance procedure as set forth in Article 15, Section 2, of the V ional Agreement.

The dispute at issue in the instant grievance is whether the grievant, a steward, was involuntarily transferred.

After further review of the matter, we mutually agreed that there was no National interpretive issue fairly presented as to the meaning and intent of Article 17 of the National Agreement.

The facts in the case, as presented in the file, indicate that the steward had a temporary change of schedule within his tour.

Accordingly, as we further agreed, this case is hereby remanded to Step 3 for further development and consideration if necessary by the parties.
