Dear Mr. Wilson:

On April 28, 1982, we met to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of the contractual grievance procedure as set forth in Article 15, Section 2, of the National Agreement.

The dispute at issue in the instant grievance is whether the grievant, a steward, was involuntarily transferred.

After further review of the matter, we mutually agreed that there was no National interpretive issue fairly presented as to the meaning and intent of Article 17 of the National Agreement.

The facts in this case, as presented in the file, indicate that the steward was temporarily assigned to another unit for three (3) hours on two occasions.

Accordingly, as we further agreed, this case is hereby remanded to Step 3 for further development and consideration if necessary by the parties.
