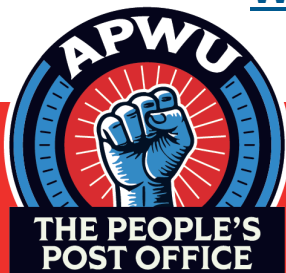
DEDICATED POSTAL WORKERS ARE STANDING UP TO SAY STOP:
