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Rickey,

PLease confirm that we agree that we are also extending the Article 15 Timelines (AKA Step 4 Timelines) through September 25, 2020, which states:

The parties agree to extend Step-4 timelines at the national leave for thirty (30) days beyond those listed in the CBA. Including meetings, "15-Day Letters", and appeals to arbitration. This agreement will begin immediately and continue through May 30, 2020 unless the parties agree otherwise.

And the 90-Day Probation Language through September 25, 2020, which states:

For all APWU represented employees, in keeping with the intent of the AVP letter on liberal scheduling and leave, and the recent MOUs regarding Dependent Care Leave and non-Career leave, in light of the COVID-19 pandemic, please implement the following guidance:

 Career, or non-career employees who are serving in their first 90 work days 90 or 120 calendar days for PSEs) will not have absences taken due to the COVID-19 pandemic cited or considered for disciplinary action or involuntary separation.
