JUNE 25 OPENING DAY OF NEGOTIATIONS

The current APWU Collective Bargaining Agreement (CBA) expires on Sept. 20, 2024. Negotiations for a new contract begin Tuesday, June 25 and the APWU will livestream our opening remarks at the negotiations table beginning at 10 a.m. Tune in to the broadcast at *apwu.org/livestream*.

APWU leadership has been working hard to prepare for Opening Day. In March, members completed a bargaining survey to express their priorities for negotiations. In April, APWU National launched a "Building Union Power" national organizing drive with the goal of signing up 5,000 new members to strengthen our collective power heading into negotiations. We have already surpassed this goal and have signed up 7,000 new members!

Opening Day is upon us, and the APWU is calling on members to show we are union proud by wearing APWU gear on June 25. Send your photos to *communications@apwu.org* so that we can show our solidarity from coast to coast!


