



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
BETWEEN THE
AMERICAN POSTAL WORKERS UNION-WESTERN REGION
AND THE
PACIFIC AREA – UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE

RE: Pasadena CFS Unassigned Regular(s) Volunteer Agreement

The parties agree to the following:

1. The Employer and the Union agree the Form 50s for each of the 13 volunteers who preferenced to the Pasadena CFS Operation will be issued with an effective date of October 28, 2017.
2. However, if the CFS workload does not move on the 28th the employees will remain detailed in the Santa Ana CFS Operation maintaining their current assignment until the CFS Operation workload has been transferred to the Pasadena facility.
3. It is agreed the employees that volunteer and go to Pasadena will retain their seniority but will not have retreat rights back to Santa Ana.
4. It is further agreed that any position that is posted for bid in the Pasadena Bid Cluster after October 28, 2017, the 13 volunteers would be entitled to bid on those positions. It's the parties understanding that the Pasadena Bid Cluster is an automated bid site. If any employee has any issues bidding, the employee(s) must immediately let their immediate supervisor know so the issue can be addressed and resolved.

The parties agree this is a non-precedential agreement and cannot be cited as a comparison in any other case. However issues evolving out the implementation of this agreement may be grieved if not resolved by the parties.
