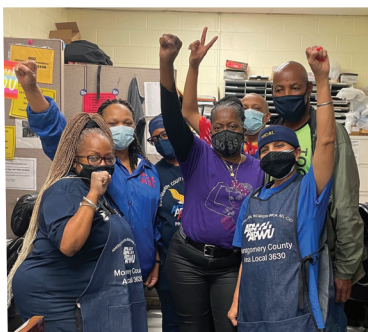


Wear Union Gear on Thursday, September 15, APWU Union Pride Day!

With rising prices across the country, our COLA is the best protection we have against inflation.

What is COLA and why does it matter?

- Maintaining our COLA was one of the most important wins in our outstanding new union contract.
- It's our protection against inflation. It guarantees that our pay increases alongside the Consumer Price Index measure of inflation.
- Few other U.S. workers receive COLA increases. We are even the only postal union that has maintained full COLA in our union contract - despite management's best attempts to remove it at contract negotiations time.
- The 2021 and 2022 COLAs combined will exceed \$5,500 annually for an average full-time career postal worker. COLA becomes part of our regular wages and thus carries over year-after-year. That means it will turn into around \$100,000 over the course of an average postal workers' career.
